We greatly value the continued collaboration between National Olympic Committees (NOCs) and WADA in the collective effort to protect clean athletes worldwide.

Your cooperation on this matter is highly appreciated and will greatly assist our colleagues at WADA in advancing this important work. Thank you for your continued commitment and collaboration. We look forward to receiving your signed declaration.
